

Property Description (from Deed)

PARCEL II

The land in Worcester, Worcester County, Massachusetts, with the buildings thereon, as shown on a Plan of Lots owned by Edward Lavallee, Worcester, Mass., January 15, 1930, recorded with the Worcester District Registry of Deeds, bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at a point in the southerly side of Rittenhouse Road, which is five hundred eight and 09/100 (508.09) feet southeasterly from the p.c. of a curve at the intersection of Rittenhouse Road with the easterly side of Flagg Street, which point is also the northeast corner of land now or formerly of one Duckworth;

Thence S. 699 50° E. by said line of Rittenhouse Road, eighty-six and 47/100 (86.47) feet to the p.c. of a curve;

Thence by a curve to the right, the radius of which is twenty-five (25) feet, thirty-five and 24/100 (35.24) feet;

Thence by the westerly line of Frontenao Street, by a curve, the radius of which is five bundred fifty-five (555) feet, eighty-nine and 4/100 (89.4) feet to land now or formetly of Thomas J. Rafferty heirs;

Thence N. 699 50° W. by said Rafferty land, and by land now or formerly of Sarah V. O'Reilly, one hundred eighteen and 33/100 (118.33) feet to land now or formerly of one Duckworth;

Thence N. 209 10° E. by said Duckworth land, one hundred ten (110) feet to the point of beginning

Containing 12,526 square feet of land, more or less.

Said premises are conveyed subject to all restrictions of record in so far as the same are now in force.
